# 2010 Weekend Adventures!

## What is a CK Weekend Adventure?

It's a terrific way to "connect" two Campus Kids weeks without going home.

## Who can go on a CK Weekend Adventure?

Campus Kids boys and girls who are "juniors" or "seniors" (entering 7, 8, 9 or 10 grades). Each weekend has a limited number of available spots. Up to 30 campers can go on a trip.



## Do we stay at Campus Kids for the weekend?

No! We leave camp on Friday afternoon when all the other campers are going home and we take a camp bus ride for about 45 minutes to our Weekend Adventure site.

### ***W.A. #1: Camping and a NYC Scavenger Hunt! (July 2-5)***

Between Weeks 1 & 2

We arrive on Friday night at **Fairview Lake Camp**, a private, beautiful site in the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area. We'll be camping out in tents and lean-tos set up in a little village around a big campfire circle. We'll have lots of time to enjoy awesome outdoor activities: boating, lake swimming, hiking, campfires (s'mores and banana boats... yummy!), beach volleyball, games and just relaxing. On Saturday, we'll have an evening activity like no other. We'll racing all over Manhattan for an amazing CK-Style Scavenger hunt and dining out near Time Square! It's sure to be an amazing time!



### ***W.A. #2: Get Wet at Camel Beach Water Park (July 16-19)***

Between Weeks 3 & 4



We arrive on Friday night at **Fairview Lake Camp**. We'll do our usual Weekend Adventure activities around the campfire and out on the lake (see above). On Saturday, we're going over to **Camel Beach Water Park**! We'll ride the slides and splash around. Test your skill on the Flow Rider! Ride with four of your friends down the Titan! Jump into the Wave Pool! This year, we'll also get to check out the newly built, Pharoh's Phortress!

### ***W.A. #3: H2-Oh-No You're Going To Mtn Creek Water Park (July 30-August 2)***

Between Weeks 5 & 6

Because you've demanded more water slides over your summer vacation, we're returning to Mountain Creek Water Park this summer! We'll be staying at our usual stomping grounds at **Fairview Lake Camp** (see Trip #1). But on Saturday we'll be screaming through the giant funnel ride, High Anxiety or racing along the Colorado River Rapids! After that we'll hit the Tarzan Swings and Cannonball Chute! It's sure to be a great time!



### ***W.A. #4: Meet Us at the Boardwalk for a Day at the Beach! (August 13-16)***

Between Weeks 7 & 8



Put on your sunscreen and get ready for a trip to the beach! We'll be camping out at Allaire state park in New Jersey. There we will do some lake swimming and hiking! On Saturday, we're getting on a bus and heading down to Point Pleasant to enjoy a day at the beach! We'll swim, sunbathe and relax. There's games and entertainment on the boardwalk! When we've had enough sun, we'll check out the Jenkinson's Aquarium!

## What is Camp Fairview Lake like?

Fairview Lake is a beautiful "outdoorsy" camp with a lake (swimming dock and boats), many acres of forests and hiking trails, some cabins and a dining hall. We'll be doing some camping out in tents and lean-tos at Fairview. We will be using the lake for swimming and boating. There are plenty of



terrific spots to hike to. We'll see deer, raccoons and even a black bear or two. We will play games, have campfires, tell stories, shoot some hoops and

have a lot of fun hanging out together. Meals will either be eaten at the camp's dining hall, cooked up over a fire or out on-the-town at a restaurant during our day trips! Fairview Lake is a YMCA camp and is ACA-Accredited and state-licensed.

## Who are the Weekend Adventure Counselors?

Sara and Jeremy will lead the trips with some of our most experienced Campus Kids staff each weekend (Vanessa & Ryan will also be there to help out). We bring plenty of qualified staff to provide safety and supervision, to lead fun activities and to just hang out with you. We have a lot of fun together! Jeremy, Sara, Ryan & Vanessa are certified in wilderness first aid, lifeguarding, & CPR and several other staff members are also lifeguards.

## Do we have rules like at Campus Kids?

Yes. We never compromise your safety. You are always with counselors. You always follow the safety rules and directions of the counselors. There are certified lifeguards at the lakes and at the water park and you always wear securely buckled lifejackets in the boats. Boys' and girls' cabins and lean-tos are separate and there is no "sneaking around". While camping out, girls' and boys' tents will be separated and supervised by staff members.

## What if I get sick or hurt?

The Weekend Adventure staff includes people specially trained in first aid-CPR and in handling emergencies in this setting. We have emergency telephones and cell phones and ready access to an ambulance and hospital if we need them. The staff at Fairview Lake is present and will provide

backup assistance in an emergency.

## What if I take medicine?

No problem. Our camp nurses send your medical form and any medications on the trip and the Weekend Adventure staff gives you your medicine.

## What do I have to bring?

Basically, you just pack up some of your stuff from Campus Kids and bring it with you. You want to have good shoes for hiking, though, and a water bottle. A flashlight is a pretty handy on these trips as well. We'll send you a detailed list for each trip. Your parents may want to sign you up for CK's weekend laundry service so your regular camp clothes will be clean for you on Monday morning.



## Can we call home?

No. You can call your family when you get back to Campus Kids on Monday (at the regular calling times). Also, there is NO cell phone use on these trips.

## How much does it cost?

\$330 per weekend if you sign up before June 1st (\$385 after that, if there's space), which includes ALL costs. Use the enclosed enrollment form to sign up. Space is strictly limited, so act quickly.
